



NURSING PROGRAM

Guidelines for Clinical Dress

Unless notified, full uniforms are to be worn for clinical rotations at all hospital sites and at all on-campus skill and sim labs. The Virginia Peninsula Community College nursing uniform consists of the following:

1. Eggplant colored scrubs, white lab coat and name tag (Purchased at VPCC's Bookstore)
2. Two Virginia Peninsula Community College Emblem Patches (Purchased at VPCC's Bookstore) – Affixed to left sleeve of each scrub top.
3. White Hose/Socks (Above the ankles) with White Shoes or Black Hose/Socks with Black Shoes
4. White or Black Nursing Shoes or Sneakers (Closed heels and toes, not canvas or with holes in top) – No bright colors, NO Crocs.
5. Watch with Second Hand.
6. Bandage Scissors.
7. Stethoscope (Dual Head).
8. Blood Pressure Cuff (Adult).
9. Hemostat.
10. Black Pen and Pad.
11. Pen Light.
12. Hair: Worn up off the collar – no ponytails. Hair must be a color that is natural in nature (no purple, pink, blue, etc.).
13. Jewelry: No necklaces, bracelets, or hoop earrings, only a single stud earring in the lower lobe is permitted. Wear a plug in any facial or tongue piercings.
14. Nails: Must be trimmed to finger-tip length and no acrylic or gel nails or tips, no nail polish.
15. Tattoos: Must be covered at all times; wear white sleeves or flesh colored bandages.
